

KNOW YOUR RIGHTS: WHEN ICE STOPS YOU IN PUBLIC



REMAIN CALM. Ask if you are free to leave or are being detained. If free to leave, walk calmly. Running away will give the impression you have something to hide. It is better to not give them any such indication.

REMEMBER YOUR IMMIGRATION NUMBER. You do not need to show foreign ID. Only share your full name. Do not provide any other information.



IF THEY ASK QUESTIONS, SAY "I WANT TO REMAIN SILENT." Do not talk about immigration status. Anything you say could be used against you in court.



IF YOU HAVE DOCUMENTS, CARRY THEM WITH YOU. (Like valid green card, I-94, Employment Authorization Card, or Border Crossing Card). **DO NOT SHOW ANY FALSE DOCUMENTS.**



YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO AN ATTORNEY. Do not answer questions without consulting an attorney.
