

KNOW YOUR RIGHTS: WHAT TO DO IF ICE SHOWS UP AT YOUR HOME



DO NOT OPEN THE DOOR. If ICE knocks on your door, ask who it is and if they say ICE or police, ask to see a judicial warrant.



IF ICE FORCIBLY ENTERS YOUR HOME, DO NOT ENGAGE WITH THEM. Start recording with your cellular device so you have evidence they entered your home without your consent.



EXERCISE YOUR RIGHT TO REMAIN SILENT. Share only your full name so your family can locate you. Let them know you will not provide any information without an attorney present.



IF YOU HAVE VALID IMMIGRATION DOCUMENTS, SHOW THEM. Do not show false documentation as that can be used against you in court.



YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO HIRE AN ATTORNEY, but the government is not required to provide a free lawyer for you. Always have an immigration attorney's phone number available so you can call for help.



DO NOT SIGN ANYTHING you do not understand or without talking to an attorney. No matter how they try to convince you that it is in your best interest, **DO NOT SIGN!**
